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What is Prenatal Care Coordination (PNCC)?

Prenatal Care Coordination (PNCC) is a free program through **Medicaid and BadgerCare Plus** that supports pregnant women in accessing the care and services they need for a healthy pregnancy and lifestyle. There are no copayments for this program.

Once enrolled, you'll be connected with a Community Health Worker who will take time to get to know you through personal assessments. They'll learn about your current and past pregnancies, health history, relationships, and any concerns you may have—so they can help support you every step of the way.

Our Daily Bread's Prenatal Care Coordination (PNCC) and Childcare Coordination (CCC) programs provide comprehensive case management services to support moms and families through every stage of the journey. Program components include:

- ✔ Regular Home Visits for personalized care and support

What is ChildCare Coordination(CCC)?

ChildCare Coordination (CCC) connects new mothers and families with the support they need after childbirth. This free benefit through **Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Plus** helps coordinate access to medical, social, educational, and vocational services based on each family's unique needs.

Available in Milwaukee and Racine Counties, CCC services begin with a DHS-approved risk assessment completed within eight weeks of birth, ensuring families receive the right care at the right time.
