# **Oil Painting YouTube Videos**

For YouTube videos, just click on the link. If your browser is not already open, it will automatically open for the video.

<u>Caravaggio Oil Technique the 17th century</u> – (15 minutes) - How Caravaggio painted. Oil painting in Italy at the beginning of the seventeenth century, the technique of Caravaggio. The video traces the techniques used by Caravaggio to paint his works: from the use of engravings and red / brown preparations, to the practice of painting directly without drawing through the use of preliminary color sketches.

<u>The DaVinci Technique – Sfumato</u> – (2hr 14 minutes) - In this video I paint the Renaissance portrait Lady with an Ermine by Leonardo Da Vinci. I try to decode his process of painting, and explain the findings of my study as thoroughly as possible. This is an invitation for all to try a study painting of the great Da Vinci without fear. I hope you will find the video useful and informative and that it will motivate you to be more in your studio.

<u>Flemish Painting Technique - Full Video Workshop</u> – (1 hr 2 6min) - The video captures the complete painting process with a layered painting technique. The video tutorial will teach you how to paint a simple realistic still life from start to finish, from preparing a non-absorbent surface to painting small details. Together we will reveal some secrets of THE Old Masters !

<u>Oil Painting Tips: How to Glaze, Scumble and ... GLUMBLE</u> – (14 min) - My favorite thing is when artists take regular techniques and ideas we all use and act as if they invented them....so, I present to you: GLUMBLING! Yes, that's right, when you add a little oil to your paint and blend it out, that's glumbling. And I made that up. It's mine. Obviously kidding...but still, I hope there's something useful in this video. I do practice these techniques all the time to correct my paintings.

<u>How to Oil Paint Wet on Wet Without Making a MESS</u> – (8 min) - How can you work wet in wet or alla prima in oil without making a muddy mess? While it takes some practice, it comes down to just a few simple steps.

<u>Top Tips for Loose Painting</u> – (18 min) - Today I want to talk about how you can achieve greater looseness in your oil paintings. No matter what subject you want to paint, when painters aim for looseness but struggle, it often comes down to the same few problems.

How to MASTER Oil Painting Alla Prima – (21 min) - What's necessary to become a professional artist and achieve mastery isn't necessarily what you think. You don't need to go to art school or paint every day to get to where you want to be.

Painting with a knife sets out to express simultaneously the form, content and all which is linked to this : shade, light, colour nuances etc... All of which is in the sense of movement and without preliminary sketches.

Turning the Raw Material of the World into Art– (14 min) Artist Ian Roberts - How do you take the raw material of the world and turn it into art? Today I will show you three photographs - a landscape, a still life, and a figure, and the analysis I go through before I begin drawing. See what I include, eliminate, and enhance because the world does not offer you a perfect picture very often. Nature gives you the raw materials. I'll show you the drawings I did of those three photographs, so you see the design, structure, and simplification. Ultimately, you're the curator; the one that finds that simplicity and coherence of art. As one artist once said, "Don't let the subject kidnap you. You're the one in charge."
