
LCAL will provide the refreshments. No alcohol is allowed.

The LCAL hosted its Spring Membership Show from May 1-17th at the <u>Carnegie Library</u> in Waukegan.

- The newly remodeled Carnegie had their grand opening on May 1st and gave the LCAL a chance to be their first exhibitor. Hundreds of visitors toured the facility to see the Carnegie's renovation and our show. It was a great opportunity and exposure for our art league and for the 29 LCAL members who entered the show.
- A critique was held on Sat. the 17th with guest critique artist <u>Tom Henrichsen</u>, an award-winning artist from Woodstock, IL, who is affiliated with Main Street Gallery in Lake Zurich.
 - Refreshments and food were served at 10 am, and the event ran until 12 pm.
- It was the first time our presentation was done using electronic projection. Visually, it was outstanding to see everyone's art up on a large screen.

Artists can exhibit their 2D works in the library lobby for 2-month time periods.



Meet Our LCAL Board Members

Ernest Schweit, Co-Director for On the Wall and for Plein Air



A photographic artist, Ernest's work focuses on the natural beauty of the Midwest, AZ, and CA. With life-long roots in the Chicago area, he and his artist-wife, Maureen, travel extensively, making art as they go.

His landscape photography is in the permanent collection of the College of Lake County and has appeared in galleries and juried art shows in Illinois and Wisconsin.

"Growing up where I did, I love the natural beauty of the Midwest; especially the lakes and forested areas of Lake County and the rural areas of Wisconsin and downstate Illinois," he said.

"Clicking the shutter is only the start. I create my personal vision playing with shape, texture and, most importantly, light and color to create my personal vision of every image I make," he said. "The final work is less literal and more of a personal interpretation."

Ernest began photography after leaving his job of 32 years as an editor at a Daily Herald newspaper in Arlington Heights, giving him the chance to pursue his passion for photography full time.

In 2009, he collaborated on an awarding-winning book, "Wisconsin Barns," in which his photographs help chronicle the love affair between Wisconsin's farmers and their barns.

His work has been featured in The Chicago Tribune, WGN-TV news, Fox News Chicago and the Lake County (IL) Journal.

I had a 20-year career as a commercial artist illustrating children's books for educational publishers and creating art for the home décor industry.

My love of French led me to a new career as a middle school French and art teacher in Waukegan for more than 13 years.

Now retired from teaching, I am re-immersed in oil painting and watercolors, and pursuing my new passion: fiber art.

I've shown my artwork at Blue Moon Gallery, the Robert Wright Gallery, Adler Arts Center, Antioch Fine Arts Foundation, and Fineline Designs Gallery in Door County, WI.
