Why Plein Air Paint?

Throughout the last 15 years or so, our group has been very active around Lake, McHenry and Cook counties doing plein air painting.

What is Plein Air Painting?

It's French for painting in open air or outdoors.

I remember the first time I joined the LCAL plein air group lead by Chris Tanner at Ryerson Woods. It was the first time I met Lee Radtke. Lee was an avid plein air painter who was active not only with our group but with the Plein Air Painters of Chicago. He had a real sense for perspective. I learned most of what I know today from him and from the many talented artists who have participated in our events.

You never know who or how many will show up -- sometimes there are as few as two or as many as 25 -- but all are welcome!

Other Group Plein Air Events in the Area

Last month, several LCAL members participated in a two-day event at LBS (Lake Barrington Shores), including Sandra Saxton, a new member of LCAL.

Sandra shared that since LBS is a gated community, artists were asked to sign up in advance. They were allowed to scope out the property on Friday and to paint Saturday and Sunday that weekend, along with 25 artists in the area. Some artists just pulled over and worked from the trunk of their car.



"Dreams of Art League Shows Gone By"

Mary's painting commemorates LCAL's 90 years.
It illustrates a favorite art league legend:
In the early 1950s, there was no public space for art shows, so on a special day, members hung their art on fisherman's nets drying at Waukegan Harbor. The harbor, seen in the distance, was then the center of a vast commercial fishery.
