#### **Interested in Judging CLC Student Artwork?**

Each year the LCAL offers \$500 scholarships to two College of Lake County (CLC) students. These students are selected based on their work, juried into the CLC Student Show which takes place in April.

One of the scholarships is funded by the Lake County Art League; the other by the Phoebe Boyd family. Phoebe Boyd was a long-time member of LCAL and upon her death, requested her family to fund an annual scholarship to a CLC student.

These programs have been in effect for many years and are part of the mission of LCAL to create more interest in art in Lake County Illinois and to develop a higher appreciation of visual art.

#### **Judging Committee:**

- The LCAL committee selecting the students is composed of three members (usually two who have done the judging before, and one new member) and the judging generally takes one morning at CLC, Grayslake campus.
- To be on the committee you must be a current LCAL member and have no relationship with the students being considered.
   It is preferred that committee members <u>not</u> be LCAL Board members.
