Past Quarter Events

In June, the Plant Operations committee held the Plant Operations June Seminar at YSI Inc. in Yellow Springs, OH. It was a unique experience as attendees got to walk through the YSI instrumentation testing and building area. Attendees learned about water reuse, pump maintenance, digital tools, PFAS in biosolids, and nutrient removal. It was a great event, and YSI was a hospitable host site. Congrats to the plant operations committee.

In July, the Young Professionals group organized a tour of Rumpke Landfill, located off Strouble Road. It was reportedly truckloads of information and mounds of fun.

In August, the Hamilton Groundwater Consortium, American Water Works Association, and Water for the People hosted the 15th anniversary Race for Global Water 5K run and walk in Fairfield, Ohio, a Water for the People benefit. In total, 225 runners and walkers crossed the finish line. The race has generated over 128K in donations over the years. Although this was a clean drinking water-related event, the clean water community has a significant overlap. I personally volunteered at the event. The current SWOWEA Vice President, Joseph Kamalesh, was the race co-chair. Additionally, many familiar faces from the Water Reclamation side volunteered and participated in the race.
