Directions to City of Hamilton WRF from I-75:

- Merge onto I-275 West and travel for ~1.5 miles;
- Take Exit 39 onto S Gilmore Road, turn right;
- Travel for ~2.2 miles and turn left onto OH-4;
- Travel for ~2.2 miles and turn left onto St. Clair Ave:
- Travel for ~1.1 miles and turn right onto River Rd;
- Travel for ~1.0 miles and turn left onto Conservation Way;
- Travel for ~ 0.3 miles to the WRF;
- Parking available in lot adjacent to the Administration Building

Directions to The Bension Event Center from the WRF:

- Head north onto Conservation Way;
