The Advance Water Course is the logical "next step" from the Basic Water course or completion of the Class I Water certification. Reasonably good grasp of basic mathematics is necessary for this course. Students are exposed to the theory of water treatment and the practical operational problems encountered in operating a water treatment system. They will be provided with an understanding of the sources of water supply, the unit treatment processes, the major types of water treatment plants used throughout Ohio, maintenance, management, record keeping, safety and emergency planning and the key provisions of drinking water regulations.
