Operator Certification Rules

As of 08/15/18 all certified operators are professionals!



Operator Certification Rules

- On <u>August 15, 2019</u>, the definition of operating experience changed:
- Operating experience
 - For applicants who <u>solely</u> have laboratory, pretreatment and engineering experience, can only use a maximum of 25% of the total operating experience requirement.



Operator Certification Rules

- Operating experience (Continued)
 - Collection and Distribution experience moved to the same provision as above when an operator is applying for a Wastewater Treatment or Water Supply Certificate.



OAC Rule 3745-7-03 and 04

- Distribution and Collection System staffing requirements:
 - Class 1 visits to the Distribution/Collection system 3 days per week.
 - Class 2 visits to the Distribution/Collection system 5 days per week.



OAC Rule 3745-7-03 and 04 (Cont.)

- Visits must be documented in the log book.
- Visit is defined and can include performing routine sampling, maintenance, or observation.



- 3745-7-06 (Certification of professional operators)
 - All applicants for certification shall complete Ohio EPA's professional operator training course.
 - Class IV exam deadline (2 years from approval)



- 3745-7-09
 - Date and times of arrival and departure shall be recorded in military time.
 - Failure to document minimum staffing is evidence that minimum staffing requirements have not been met.



- Report minimum staffing times to the agency on a form approved by the Director
 - Began reporting in November 2018.
 - Guidance and youtube video for PWS.
 - Guidance for eDMR.
 - Better reporting being developed.




- OAC Rule 3745-7-15
 - Renewal applications must be submitted electronically.
 - Due date for renewals is November 30th of the expiration year.
 - Grace period reduced to 6 months. June 30th.
 - All operators renewing must complete the Ohio EPA professional operator certification training course.



- OAC Rule 3745-7-21 (Contract Operator Rule)
 - As of September 15, 2018, must be approved by the Director prior to acting as the ORC.

Contingency Plan

- Required by Asset Management Rules.
- A document or group of documents designed to ensure the delivery of safe drinking water at all times.



Contingency Plan

When routine methods of delivery or treatment are compromised, the contingency plan shall provide for the protection of public health to the extent possible, through actions including but not limited to the notification of users, including the direct notification of critical users, the provision of alternate sources of water and the restoration of service.

Mechanical Failure – Potassium Permanganate



Unplanned Absence of Operator



MCL Exceedances – Sebring Ohio



Tornado - Dayton



Flooding – Hamilton, Ohio



Locations of the Plan

- At the water plant
 - Accessible and secure
 - Available to operator and staff
 - Available 24/7 to representatives of the Director or emergency response personnel.
- Within five days of a request by the Ohio EPA, a copy of the contingency plan shall be submitted in a format acceptable to Ohio EPA.

Protection Agency

Contents of the Plan

- Circumstances that will affect the system
- A description of the procedures to be followed
 - Sampling plans including sample points
 - Treatment options
 - Notifications
- Actions necessary to maintain or restore service to customers



Circumstances

- Pump or motor failure
- Loss of water from well
- Line breaks
- Absence of an operator
- MCL violations
- Treatment Technique violations



Notifications

- Identify the method and timing of notification
 - Users
 - Ohio EPA
 - Local Health Dept
 - Local EMA



COVID -19

- Currently not thought to be a threat of contamination to a water supply
- Bigger concern is workforce issues.
- What does your contingency plan say about absence of an operator?
 - Discuss backing up with neighboring utilities
 - WARN
 - Consider sheltering workers who are not ill at the plant.




New Legislation

 - Reciprocity for individuals holding licensure in other states




