Job Duties:

Manages and coordinates employees' work activities associated with the sanitary sewer collection system. Schedules sanitary sewer taps and maintenance/repairs of; lift stations, sanitary sewer lines, air releases, manholes, I/I removal, etc. with both district employees and approved contractors. Maintains a safe and secure work environment, perform various unskilled and skilled task including, but not limited to: repair and installation of sanitary sewer lines, taps, manholes, air releases and pumps. Performs preventative and service maintenance on lift stations. Cleans and maintains sanitary sewer lines. Responds to customer sanitary sewer issues. Manual labor such as: digging, lifting, jackhammer, etc. Maintenance of treatment plant to include: equipment repair, plumbing repair and weed control. Knowledge of SCADA system operation. Assist equal or higher classified personal. Cleans and maintains department equipment including: hand tools, vehicles, workshop, heavy equipment, etc. Performs other related work as required.

Additional Job Duties:

Obtain and review pricing from contractor and vendors. Submit requisitions for materials and contractor services. Submit reports and respond to OEPA inquiries. Operation of sanitary sewer video inspection camera equipment, perform inspections on grease traps and new sanitary sewer lines. May perform portions of the work of higher classified positions occasionally as assigned.

Major Work Characteristics:

Essential employee, mandatory overtime. Supervising skills, training new employees. Knowledge of safe work practices and procedures involving the use of hand and/or power tools. Ability to read and understand utility mapping, carry out detailed written or oral instructions, maintain a log of activities, demonstrate dexterity and skillful use of hands. Recognize safety warnings, stand, and walk and bend continuously.

Minimum Requirements:

Exposed to raw sewage, tolerance to odor. May be exposed to various extreme weather conditions (e.g., heat, cold, rain, snow, sun). May work evening shift. May be exposed to general outside hazards such as poison ivy or oak.
