Essential Functions:

Line Investigation and Maintenance - Conduct smoke testing by operating and maintaining smoke blower, gathering drainage information, and operating camera; monitor flow; conduct dye water flooding; conduct manhole inspections and checks for structural soundness; locate and mark sewer lines; and operate easement machine, sewer jet, T.V. truck or Vactor.

Repair - Correct sewer line problems; and rehabilitate manholes (e.g., change castings, coordinate with other utilities to bring up to grade, waterproof, etc.).

Preventive Maintenance - Clean sewer blockages, wet wells, and treatment tanks; and perform scheduled sewer cleanings.
