ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Repairs, 20% of the time

Performs unskilled, semi-skilled and skilled tasks to assist with installation and repair of water distribution system, (e.g., assists with installation of taps into system, assists with repair of water line breaks, , etc.); repair, (e.g., disassembles, treats with chemical solution and repairs or replaces worn or defective parts, assists in replacing large meters; and repairs water main breaks, sewer line problems, fire hydrants, water and sewer lines, sewer backups, etc.

Equipment Operation, 20% of the time

Operates various heavy equipment, (e.g., backhoe, loader, sewer jet, jack hammer and dump truck).

Hydrant Work, 15% of the time

Performs preventive maintenance on hydrants; and repairs and replaces broken hydrants.

Maintenance, 10% of the time

Performs routine maintenance of equipment, (e.g., backhoes, valve exerciser, , etc.); performs custodial work at wastewater treatment plant, (e.g., empties trash, shovels snow, cuts grass, etc.) tool and supply care, inventory and ordering, etc.

Crew Leading, 30% of the time

Leads crew in the performance of daily activities by supervising the job site: instructs personnel on the proper use of equipment; provides training on specific procedures that are performed by section employees; ensures that all work is done in a safe and efficient manner in accordance with BCWS procedures and policies; ensures compliance with OEPA, safety and other applicable mandates.

Other Duties as Required, 5% of the time

Performs other duties as required.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have the ability to engage in manual labor over extended periods of time under varied conditions and the willingness to respond to after-hours emergency situations. Must have a valid Ohio Driver's with a Class A CDL and tanker endorsement with Air Brakes and Pintle Hitch. Must have a high school education or the equivalent thereof.
