RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS:

- Operates wastewater equipment including dissolved air flotation (DAF) systems.
- Assists in maintaining and repairing pumps and other wastewater equipment when needed.
- Setting chemical pumps as needed and mixing chemicals.
- Performing basic lab procedures to test water quality.
- Adheres to all safety requirements including PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), preventing and reporting unsafe acts and conditions, Lockout-Tagout procedures, and Process Safety Management related matters.
- Maintains a clean and safe working environment.
- Participates in Company and department safety programs.
- All other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Ability to speak, read, write, and understand English fluently.
- High school diploma/GED or equivalent.
- Must have a valid driver's license.
- Must be certified Ohio Wastewater Operator Class II or above
- Mechanical inclination and/or experience preferred.
- Basic math skills.
- Availability to work a somewhat flexible schedule.
- Ability to work quickly and multitask.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions, if applicable.

- Occasionally works in an outside environment, including in inclement weather.
- May be exposed to temperatures below 28 degrees or up to 100 degrees Fahrenheit with both ambient and 100% humidity.
- Work around animal odors.
- May be exposed to noise ranges of up to 110 db.
- Must wear and use protective and safety equipment required for the job as directed by the Company.
- Must frequently lift up to 25lbs and occasionally lift up to 70 lbs.
- Exposure to dust, feathers, and chemicals used in the poultry processing facility.
- Ability to work in a stationary position, on feet for the entire shift.
