WATER PLANT OPERATOR

It is anticipated that a vacancy for the position of Water Plant Operator exist. The job pays \$19.78 per hour and is adjusted according to the terms of Local #677 contract. The shift will be determined once position is filled. The job requires the person awarded the position be capable of operating the Filtration Plant and Pump Station, as well as the outlying booster stations. The position also carries associated responsibilities such as cleaning an area of the plant assigned to your shift. Operators are also responsible for monitoring the levels of the tanks to insure they are kept full. The successful bidder will be responsible for selecting correct rate of flow at the plant to meet the current circumstances. The job includes starting and shutting off pumps, answering phone calls and checking on reported water leaks and notifying the proper employee on call for that event. After hours is also required. The successful candidate must have a driver's license, be willing to work overtime when needed and be capable making repairs when needed on equipment associated with the water plant and system. The successful applicant will be expected to become familiar with the operation of the entire Water system and become familiar with terminology associated with the plant and system. **Operators are responsible for proper operation of the plant during their shift** as well as taking corrective actions when needed to be capable of making some mathematical calculations. (EXAMPLE: converting PSI into feet of head. Converting mg/l to lbs./day on a given flow of water expressed in MGD. Converting gallons/day to gallons per minute.) **Successful candidate will have 24 months to obtain a class I water supply operator's license.** Evaluation will be completed before probationary period expires.
