General:

The City of Ironton owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility designed for a maximum daily flow of 3.4 MGD, which is located along and discharges to the Ohio River. This facility currently requires a State of Ohio certified Class III Operator. The facility serves a population of approximately 11,130 as well as many commercial and industrial businesses in the City of Ironton. The sewer lines range from 8" – 92" in diameter and consist of combined and separated sewers. There are 12 storm water pumping stations (maintained by others), 8 sanitary lift stations and 8 combined sewer overflows.

Scope of Services:

- 1. Provide technical support to operate and maintain the facility and sanitary lift stations.
- 2. Monitor and report occurrences of sanitary sewer and combined sewer overflows to the Owner and the Ohio EPA
- 3. Schedule standard monthly testing involved and/or required by the OEPA in order to meet the facilities requirements.
- 4. Prepare and submit monthly reports required by the OEPA with an informational copy being submitted to the Owner.
- 5. Prepare annual preventive maintenance plans.
- 6. Provide planning for system failure, natural disasters, or emergency situations for Owner's implementation.
- 7. Report to the owner on the condition and operation of the facility.
- 8. Be available on a 24-hour basis to handle any sewer system emergencies that may arise.
- 9. Respond to correspondence from the Ohio EPA regarding the facility.
- 10. Meet Ohio EPA requirements for time spent on-site.
