

Water Treatment Plant Operator City of Milford, Ohio

The City of Milford, Ohio, is seeking applicants for the position of Water Treatment Plant Operator. The City of Milford, Ohio is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Water Operator with a minimum Class 1 license preferred or required within two years of the date of hire. Responsibilities include maintenance and repair of lines, meter reading, operation and repair of equipment, and knowledge of treatment processes and laboratory procedures. An Ohio Class B CDL license must be obtained within six months of hire.

This entry-level position is an excellent career opportunity for someone interested in ongoing training towards becoming a licensed Water Treatment Plant Operator within two years, passing the Ohio EPA Certification exam.

Responsibilities include maintaining test results and maintenance records in accordance with OEPA standards and City procedures, monitoring plant gauges, feeders, reading and maintaining City water meters, and assisting in the repair of main breaks, valve replacements, and fire hydrants as needed. This safety-sensitive position is subject to a background check and random drug and alcohol screening. In addition, all applicants will be subject to a competitive exam before consideration for employment
