- Currently hold a valid Ohio CDL Driver's License, Class B, with manual transmission and airbrake endorsement.
- Candidates must currently possess OEPA Class II Wastewater. Must be able to obtain an OEPA Class
 III Wastewater Operator license within 12 months from start date. There is not an inherent right to
 this job if successful passage of licensure requirements is not completed within the specified
 timeframe.

- Assists in developing and conducting training and safety program.
- Prepares reports and maintains records.
- Determines remedial actions in emergencies.
- Requisitions supplies and equipment for the operation of the plant.
- Can be expected to work at any time and will work shifts.
- May be required to perform duties of a Wastewater Operator when needed.
- Consistently checks and responds to incoming email communication.
- Performs other work or duties assigned by supervisor or designee.
