

Details: The City of Painesville is accepting applications for the full-time position of Water Treatment Chief Operator at the Water Treatment Plant.

Qualifications: Applicants must have a High School Diploma, or equivalent. A valid Ohio Driver's License; Valid Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement required within one year of appointment or at time of hire. Candidates for appointment to this position must possess and maintain a Class III Operator Water Supply certificate at time of appointment to this position, as issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. Must obtain and maintain an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency lab certification within one (1) year of appointment. Candidate shall have five (5) years from date of appointment to obtain a Class IV Operator Water Supply Certificate as issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and maintain thereafter.

Work involves responsibility for the continuous operation and maintenance of the City's Water Treatment Plant. Supervision is exercised over the Water Operations/Maintenance Technicians at the water treatment plant ("operators"). The Chief Operator, through conferences and analysis of operating records and reports, reviews the operators work. The Chief Operator must fill in for Plant Operators, Laboratory technicians and Maintenance personnel on a regular basis.

Supervision: Work is performed with considerable independence within the framework of departmental policies and governing laws, ordinances, and regulations.
