JOB SUMMARY:

Under direct supervision of the Assistant Service Director, operate and maintain the municipal water treatment plant; performing a variety of tasks, including laboratory analysis.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- Perform monitoring and recording of supply and storage levels and pumping demands and demands on the distribution system.
- Perform various chemical, biological, and bacterial testing and analysis required by federal and state regulatory agencies including signing of EPA reports.
- Monitor and assess correct chemical dosage for proper treatment of the raw water supply.
- Perform routine maintenance of valves, pumps, piping and related equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of the treatment of raw water supply facility and distribution system.
- Participate in excavation of and perform repair of broken water mains in the distribution system as required.
- Consult with and provide information for the Assistant Service Director regarding the treatment plant operations.
- Monitor, analyze and convey information regarding EPA regulations to the Chief Operator and assist in promulgation and implementation of appropriate policies to ensure compliance.
- Perform service line connection inspections as required.
- Other duties as may be required or assigned, including assisting other divisions to achieve assigned tasks.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to read, analyze and understand various directives and regulations of federal and state regulatory agencies.
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints of the distribution system and treatment facility.

Ability and mechanical skill to perform maintenance tasks within the treatment facility and in the distribution system.

- Knowledge and appreciation of safety requirements regarding handling of hazardous chemicals and hazardous work environments.
- Knowledge and ability to safely monitor and appropriately adjust chemical feeding equipment.
- Ability to accurately determine, record and report changing conditions regarding the pumping, storage, demand, supply or any other operational demands of the water treatment and distribution system.
- Ability to draw/record locations and write reports.
- Acute judgment and appreciation in analyzing problems and alerting appropriate officials of any major problem affecting the potable water supply and/or public safety.
- Ability to evaluate, research and communicate to the Assistant Service Director the needs
 of the department.
- Report to work on time and maintain consistent and predictable attendance.
- Other duties as may be required or assigned, including assisting other divisions to achieve assigned tasks.
