- High school or General Educational Development (GED) Tests equivalency. Journeyman's Card in the electrical trade or possession of a City of Toledo Journeyman Electrician's License. Valid Driver's License.
- Training should include experience in the calibration and troubleshooting of electronic and related instrumentation equipment.

Physical Demands:

In this position, the employee will occasionally stand and frequently walk and sit. The position will frequently require the employee to drive a personal and company owned vehicle. The employee will occasionally lift, push, pull, drag and/or move up to 128 pounds. The employee will frequently carry up to 50 pounds. Occasional stooping, kneeling, crawling, and crouching may occur with this position. Speaking and listening are constant essential functions of this position.
