<u>Superintendent – Sanitary Sewer Department</u>

The Logan County Sewer District has an immediate opening for a Superintendent for the Sanitary Sewer Department. The ideal candidate for this position will promote a positive and effective workplace through a collaborative approach with staff and should have extensive knowledge of sanitary sewer system construction, operation, maintenance, and rehabilitation practices. The Superintendent is an administrative position and reports to the Logan County Sewer District Director. In addition to direct oversight of the Sanitary Sewer Department, this position will perform various administrative tasks including annual operating and capital budgets, enforcement of district policy and sewer use rules, reviewing and approving invoices from vendors and contractors, preparing various reports as well as providing relevant safety and skills training to staff.

The Logan County Sewer District operates two sanitary sewer systems with a total of approximately 75 miles of gravity sewers, 100 miles of pressure sewers, 32 pump stations, and 300+ grinder pump stations. The Sewer District is well equipped and staffed to perform routine operation & maintenance tasks.

A criminal background check and drug screening is required. Experience in sanitary sewer construction, operation, maintenance, and rehabilitation of sanitary sewer systems and at least two years of supervisory or leadership experience is preferred. An Ohio EPA Class II Collection Operator License or Class II Wastewater Operator License is required. A candidate with a Class I Wastewater Collection Operator License or Class I Wastewater Treatment Operator License may be considered for the position with a requirement to obtain a Class II license. Must possess a valid Ohio Driver License and an acceptable driving record is required at all times during employment. A minimum of a Class B CDL with tanker and air brake endorsements is required within 18 months of hire.

Logan County offers a benefits package that includes a pension program through Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, Vacation Time is earned according to years of service credit, Sick leave is earned upon the number of hours worked with a maximum of 120 hrs per year, health insurance, and prescription drug plan is provided with options for supplemental (vision/dental) insurance available. The annual salary range for this position is \$83,525 to \$90,354 depending on qualifications and licensing.
