What is Positive Response?

- Positive Response is a closing of the communication loop.
- It allows each facility owner to communicate to the excavator the status of their one call ticket.
- All facility owners who are members of a protection service are required to participate in the positive response system provided by the protection service.
- Remember to check positive response prior to excavation.

Positive Response Codes

- 001- No Conflict
- 002- Marked (Up to Privately Owned Utility)
- 003- Ticket Cancelled
- 004- Excavation Request could not be Completed
(Facility Owner/Locator will contact the Excavator Directly)
- 005- Excavation Request could not be Completed
(Bad Address or Incorrect Street Information, a New Ticket is Requested)
- 006- High Profile Facility
(Facility/Owner Request to be Present for Excavation)
- 007- Joint Meet/Large Project
(Will Coordinate with the Excavator)
- 008- Design Ticket (Contractor was Notified by the Facility Owner)
- 009- Work has been Completed Upon Arrival



- Use Positive Response to see how each utility company has responded to your excavation request and use the near ticket feature to find out if there are excavations taking place near your current location.


