- 2016 Proposals for change to the Current Operator Certification Rules
- Throughout the rules we will be referring to operators as "Professionals"
- 3745-7-01 (Definitions)
- Changes to the definition of operating experience
- Moving laboratory, pretreatment and engineering maximum of 25% of the total operating experience components to experience which only counts for a requirement
- Collection and Distribution experience moved to the Wastewater Treatment or Water Supply Certificate same provision when an operator is applying for a

- Class 1 visits to the collection system 3 days per week

- Addition of a provision holding backup operators responsible for violations that occur while they are statting a plant
- Waiver of daily visit requirement with continuous monitoring

- Report minimum staffing times to the agency on a torm approved by the Director



- 3745-7-13 (Reciprocity)
- Fee clarification
- 3745-7-15 (Expiration and renewal of professional operator certification)
- Requirement for electronic submission of renewal applications beginning with certificates that expire December 31, 2018
- Moving official due date for renewals to November 30 of the expiration year
- Switching grace period from 1 year to 6 months



- 3745-7-15 (Expiration and renewal of professional operator certification)
- Within 30 days of the effective date of the rule all training attendance documentation providers will be required to electronically submit
- Clarification that training providers must notify Ohio EPA of each training session
- Allowance for a third party course approval program
- Penalty provisions for not following course approval requirements





Ohio EPA will and then seek State of Ohio certification for all levels of certification except Class IV. ABC (ABC) as an approved examination provider. Operators may now choose to take an ABC examination paper and pencil testing. The State of Ohio has approved the Association of Boards of Certification examinations, which are available more frequently and in more locations than Ohio EPA's traditional


- Schedule an examination through ABC
- Application for certification through an approved exam provider To be completed by an operator who has passed an exam given by an approved examination provider (e.g., ABC)

Applying for Certification

- After passing the exam, Application for Certification through eBusiness Center
- \$45 fee
- Submit only after eligibility requirements can be documented
- Print, sign and mail paper application



Traditional Paper and Pencil Exams

- Offered 2 times per year
- Ohio Expo Center
- Application to Ohio EPA
- Fee dependent on level of examination
- Documentation of experience in detail
- through the eBusiness Center All exam applications must be submitted electronically
- Certificate Issuance
- Operator-in-Training (OIT) Applicants must wait until required documentation form experience can be documented to submit an Operator in Training
