



 - ABC Application review
 - Sequential examinations
 - Code of Conduct





Two Pathways for Certification using ABC Testing

- 2. Ohio EPA Testing Service
 - Application (attestation)
 - Immediate registration
 - Full fees required for a retake



Two Pathways for Certification using ABC Testing

- Ohio EPA Testing Service Advantages
 - EPA equivalent exam
 - 30 day retake waiting period

How to Become an Ohio EPA Certified Operator

ABC is an approved exam provider for Ohio EPA. As an approved exam provider, ABC offers computerized operator certification exams five-six days per a week at approximately 200 assessment center locations across the United States. Ohio EPA operator certification exams available through this program include:

- · Water Supply, Classes A, I, II, and III
- · Water Distribution, Classes I and II
- . Wastewater Treatment, Classes A, I, II, and III
- · Wastewater Collection, Classes I and II

Steps to obtain your Ohio EPA certification through this program are as follow:



- 2. If you meet the eligibility criteria, go to AMP's website to start registering for your examination.
 - · Select the category: Water/Wastewater.
 - · Select the program: Ohio EPA.
 - · Select the appropriate examination.
- During your registration for the examination, you will be required to attest to your eligibility and intent to apply for Ohio EPA certification.
- Once you have passed your exam, submit your examination results, <u>Ohio EPA application for certification</u>, and applicable fees to Ohio EPA.



How does an operator get Ohio EPA certified?


- Application to Ohio EPA

- Paper and pencil tests will still be offered 2 times per year at the Ohio Expo Center



















Operational Records

- OAC 3745-7-09
 - "Accurate and Authentic"
 - Maintained onsite available for 24 hour inspection
 - At a minimum, the following information shall be recorded:
 - (a) Identification of the public water system, sewerage system, or treatment works;
 - (b) Date and times of arrival and departure for the operator of record and any other operator required by this chapter;



Operational Records

- (c) Specific operation and maintenance activities that affect or have the potential to affect the quality or quantity of sewage or water conveyed, effluent or water produced;
- (d) Results of tests performed and samples taken, unless documented on a laboratory sheet;
- (e) Performance of preventative maintenance and repairs or requests for repair of the equipment that affect or have the potential to affect the quality or quantity of sewage or water conveyed, effluent or water produced; and
- (f) Identification of the persons making entries.
