Ohio EPA Paper/Pencil Exams


- Offered 2 times per year
 - Ohio Expo Center
- Application to Ohio EPA
 - Fee dependent on level of examination
 - Documentation of experience in detail
 - Exam applications will <u>only</u> be accepted through eBusiness
 Center
- Certificate Issuance
 - Operator-in-Training (OIT) Applicants must wait until
 required experience can be documented

Third Party Exams

- Ohio EPA Testing Service
 - Application (attestation)
 - Immediate registration
- Immediate results
- 30 day re-take waiting period
- Re-take as many times as needed (offered year round)
- Approved Exam Provider
 - Association of Boards of Certification (ABC)
 - 5 locations
 - 3 hour test
 - 100 questions
 - Internationally recognized





Approved Examination Providers

Ohio EPA is pleased to announce alternative water and wastewater operator certification examinations, which are available more frequently and in more locations than Ohio EPA's traditional paper and pencil testing. The State of Ohio has approved the Association of Boards of Certification (ABC) as an approved examination provider. Operators may now choose to take an ABC examination and then seek State of Ohio certification for all levels of certification except Class IV. ABC examinations will be offered in Cleveland, Cincinnati, Columbus, Dayton and Toledo. Ohio EPA will continue to offer paper and pencil examinations in Columbus in the spring and fall of each year. Applications for the traditional paper and pencil testing are available above. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the operator certification unit at 1-866-411-OPCT (6728) or by email. How to Become an Ohio EPA Certified Operator

ABC is an approved exam provider for Ohio EPA. As an approved exam provider, ABC offers computerized operator certification exams five-six days per a week at approximately 200 assessment center locations across the United States. Ohio EPA operator certification exams available through this program include:


- · Water Supply, Classes A, I, II, and III
- · Water Distribution, Classes I and II
- · Wastewater Treatment, Classes A, I, II, and III
- · Wastewater Collection, Classes I and II

Steps to obtain your Ohio EPA certification through this program are as follow:

Review the eligibility criteria below to determine whether you may sit for the exam. If you have any
questions regarding your eligibility, contact Ohio EPA at opcert@epa.state.oh.us or 1-866-411-OPCT
(6728).

A	High school diploma or equivalent	1040 hours*
I	High school diploma or equivalent	12 months
II	High school diploma or equivalent	36 months*
III	High school diploma or	60 months, including 12 months







- 2. If you meet the eligibility criteria, go to AMP's website to start registering for your examination.
 - · Select the category: Water/Wastewater.
 - · Select the program: Ohio EPA.
 - · Select the appropriate examination.
- During your registration for the examination, you will be required to attest to your eligibility and intent to apply for Ohio EPA certification.
- Once you have passed your exam, submit your examination results, <u>Ohio EPA application for certification</u>, and applicable fees to Ohio EPA.

Third Party Exams

- ABC Testing Service
 - Exam Fee \$46 (paid every time)
 - Exam administration fee \$64
 - Total \$110
- The above totals do not include the certification fee through Ohio EPA.



Applying for Certification

- After passing a Third Party Exam
- Application for Certification through eBusiness
 Center
- \$45 fee
- Submit only after eligibility requirements can be documented
- Print, sign, and mail paper application

Welcome to the Ohio EPA Operator Certification Unit eBusiness page. Operators will now be able to access their operator profile, update contact information, view completed courses, submit a variety of applications and even pay program fees electronically. Training Providers will be able to update program contact information, apply for courses, upload course schedules and upload course attendance information for operators. Online access to our more popular applications, payments, and features should streamline the paperwork process and provide the most information in the least amount of time to Ohio's Operators and Training Providers.  - NOTE: If you are a Training Provider that had valid contact hour course approval numbers on or before August 1, 2014 you may already have an account. Please contact Operator Certification before creating a new account.

 - NOTE: If you have a certificate, or if you have ever applied for an exam, certificate, or OIT status with Ohio EPA, you have a Core Person ID number. Your core person ID is the middle seven digits of your certification number. If you are not sure of your core person ID please contact the operator certification unit at 1-866-411-OPCT (6728) before selecting "No" and creating a new Core Person ID number.
 - Training Provider Service
 - NOTE: the Training Provider Service and the Operator Service should NOT be activated
 under the same user account. If your Training Provider contact person is also a Certified
 Operator, they will need to create a separate account for personal operator functions.
 They will maintain separate Usernames, Passwords, and PINs for the Training Provider
 account and their Operator Account.

- PIN = Personal Identification Number
- To get a PIN:
 - Submit an electronic request
 - Print and complete the Subscriber Agreement form (Form must be notarized)
 - Mail form to Ohio EPA PIN will be mailed back to you
 - Activate PIN on eBiz
- PIN is required to submit <u>any</u> application

Protection Agency

Course Approvals

- Faster turn around time
- Same time restrictions apply for both Training Provider and Operator Applications
 - Apply and Schedule prior to or within 30 days of completion
- Training Providers upload attendance records
 - This will connect courses with operators



Course Approvals

FAQ

- Should I submit a course approval application if I don't see a course on my list?
- How do I know the course I took has been approved?
- I attended a training out of state and want contact hours for it. It's close to the 30 days deadline and I don't have my proof of attendance. What do I do?



Exam Applications

- Paper applications are no longer accepted
- One time detailed employment info entry
- Print off, sign and mail paper application
- Email confirmations:
 - Submission confirmation
 - Exam Entrance Letter
 - Check Spam folder



Third Party Exam Certification

- Fully converted to electronic applications
- Must meet experience requirements <u>before</u> you apply
 - Class III must meet all requirements before taking the exam
- Still need to mail the application
 - Signed by supervisor and applicant



Renewal Applications

- Over 6,000 renewal applications were mailed out in September.
- Electronic Renewals available August 1st
- What courses are accessible on eBusiness?
 - Most courses are available
 - Most attendance is uploaded
 - Operators can upload their own course/contact hour information <u>after August 1st</u> of renewal year
