WATER TREATMENT PLANT PROFESSIONAL WATER SUPPLY OPERATOR

Requirements:

- Must possess a minimum of an OEPA Class I Water Supply License
- Able to lift at least 50lbs
- Able to work in confined spaces
- Achieve certification for basic chemical and bacteriological lab testing
- Basic knowledge of electronic controls and systems (0-5V, 5-20mA, 120VAC, 240VAC, etc.)
- Able to service mechanical equipment
- Able to climb and perform work duties on elevated platforms
- Valid driver's license
- Must pass drug test

Primary Job Duties:

- Run daily lab testing
- Make adjustments to chemical feeds and flow rates through the treatment plant
- Collect samples within the treatment plant and distribution system for routine sample monitoring
- General maintenance, repair and replacement of treatment plant equipment
- Backwashing filters
- Record daily readings for chemical feeds and flows
- Maintenance of grounds around the facility
- Operate heavy equipment (backhoe) as needed

Hours and Rate of Pay:

Monday thru Friday 7:00am to 3:00pm (40+ hours/week. Weekend and holiday rotation are required once training period has completed)
