

Dear Grace Lutheran Family,

I am still writing my stories on my blank pages. Are you? I am so thankful to God for granting me 151 stories to write. I am now left with 214. This month, I shared news from the mission field.

Three months ago, we asked you to assist with a donation to purchase cement bags for the school roof in Liberia. You came through with your donations. Thank you! Today, we have placed all the beams in position to install the aluminum zinc. This is a significant development for the mission.

Additionally, I would like to share Peter's story from the mission field. Peter (not his real name, to protect his identity), a 13-year-old boy who helped his mother sell in the community, came to the school in Liberia and declared his intention to attend school. After a brief conversation with him and his parents, the school administrators discovered that Peter was not in school because he could not afford tuition. Today, Peter is in school because he received a 100 % scholarship. Thank you for your sponsorship.

This year, we made a total of 85 dresses, 63 hygiene kits and 24 infant layettes. These were divided between the barrel for Liberia and the Orphan Grain Train. Since this group started 2669 dresses and 648 hygiene kits have been made and distributed.


