Meet the Williams Family

If you happen to pass a table full of pears and smiling faces on the corner of 195th and Everett late summer, you've likely encountered the Williams family—and their heartwarming initiative, "Pears with a Purpose." But this fun-loving, community-minded family is just as comfortable navigating a 40-foot RV across the country as they are raising money for good causes in their Grasmere neighborhood.

Pete, 46, and Meghan, 44, Williams, along with daughters Addison, 15, and Ellenore, 12, have created a life filled with adventure, connection, and purpose that is rooted in Mokena, but rolling far beyond it.

High School to Happily Ever After

Pete and Meghan both grew up in Tinley Park and attended Andrew High School, where they initially just "knew of each other." It wasn't until their friend groups merged a few years later that a romance began to take shape. "We married in October of 2005 after dating for five years," Meghan shares.

Their educational paths also reflect their strong work ethic. Pete earned both his bachelor's and MBA from Lewis University and is now a project manager for National Express, a national transportation company. Meghan's journey took her from Columbia College to Lewis University, where she earned a marketing degree and minor in art. She later received a master's in organizational leadership from Concordia University and now works as a Senior Category Marketing Manager at Ace Hardware Corporation, recently celebrating 20 years with the company.

Life in Grasmere


The Williams family moved to Mokena's Grasmere subdivision in 2017 to be closer to family and to take advantage of top-rated schools. "We loved the small-town feel. The neighborhood is quiet but active with people enjoying their homes, yards, and families," says Meghan, who appreciates her neighbors and considers them more like family. "Some have lived here since the homes were built. We help each other out and share advice. It's really special."

Their daughter Addison just finished her freshman year at Lincoln-Way Central High School and is active in basketball, choir, the Madrigals, Treblemakers Club, and the school musical. Ellenore, who is going into 7th Grade at Mokena Junior High, participates in Orchestra, Symphonic Band, cross country, the school musical stage crew, and Girl Scouts. Her troop even painted a "mural of kindness" at Mokena Intermediate School as part of their Bronze Award project.

Great Causes

The Williams family is a team that stays busy with purpose. Meghan has volunteered as a Girl Scout Troop leader for seven years and serves on the board of the Weimaraner Club of Northern Illinois. Their current 6-year-old Weimaraner, Banks, is learning to point birds using his instincts. Their Great Dane, Walt, 3, rounds out the pack.

"Weimaraner's always get Cubs names, like Banks after Ernie Banks, and Great Danes get Disney names," Pete says. Their first dog, Wrigley, was no ordinary pup. "He was inducted



into the DockDogs Hall of Fame in 2015. He competed in six DockDogs World Championships and was even a finalist in the televised 2012 Purina Incredible Dog Challenge."

When they're not chasing adventures with their dogs, they're helping others, like with "Pears with a Purpose," where the family sells pears from their backyard tree to raise thousands for hurricane relief and local families in need.

RV Life

The Williams family's passion for travel took off during the pandemic. "COVID forced us to slow down and spend more time together," explains Pete. "We decided an RV was a safe way to get out and explore."

What began with a 2021 Winnebago Outlook has grown into life on the road in a 2023 Entegra Accolade XL 37L, a 40-foot powerhouse with three slide-outs, sleeping space for nine (plus two dogs), a full kitchen, and even a fireplace. "With a motorhome, the trip starts the moment you start driving," Meghan says. "We have access to the fridge, snack drawer, and bathroom. We can stretch out and just enjoy the ride."

Since 2020, the Williamses have logged over 62,000 miles and will soon have spent 310 nights in their motorhomes across 29 states. Each big trip is carefully planned, often inspired by RV YouTubers, with at least one National Park each year and a pin map marking their growing list of destinations.


A favorite adventure? Driving the Jeep on Beartooth Highway to a summit of 11,000 feet near Yellowstone. "We took a different 'scenic' route back that took five hours longer than expected," Pete laughs. "By the time we reached Cody, Wyoming, we were starving, and still had 3.5 hours left to get back to our campground. We got in just before midnight. It was a day to remember."

When they're not on the road, the Williams family enjoys local favorites like Zap Tacos, The Creamery, SPENGA Mokena, and pickleball at Grasmere Park. They're also diehard Cubs fans, a passion that runs deep. "Pete's parents grew up blocks from Wrigley Field," Meghan explains.

And when they finally have a rare free weekend? "We catch up on yard work, hang with friends for a game night, or head out to dinner," says Pete.

The Williamses share their RV adventures, lessons, and laughs on their travel vlog and social channels: Our Captain's Logs. "We document our travels, engage with other travel enthusiasts, and inspire others to travel," Meghan says.

Since its inception more than 20 years ago, it has been a safe, welcoming space where women can ask questions, share concerns, and receive guidance from experts who understand the unique challenges of breast health.

Women age 40 and older, or younger women with a family history of breast cancer, are encouraged to schedule their mammogram. Appointments can be booked online at FranciscanHealth.org/BreastCare or by calling 833-764-5434.

"Breast cancer is more treatable—and in many cases curable—than ever before," said Hicks. "By putting your health first and making time for screenings, you give yourself the best chance to live an extraordinary, healthy life for the ones who love and count on you."

The Forest Preserve District of Will County held a pelican party last month to celebrate the arrival of countless pelicans that stop by McKinley Woods preserve as they migrate south this fall. Offering the rare chance to get an up-close look at a pelican, naturalists were stationed at pelican hotspots throughout the preserve to help visitors spot the soaring flocks. The American white pelican is the largest migratory bird in the United States, second only in wingspan to the California condor. With wings that can stretch nearly 9 feet across, the birds appear massive but weigh only about 15 pounds. They visit Four Rivers twice a year during their migrations, and right now they're headed south to the Gulf Coast for their winter-feeding grounds.
