This week I talked about reading! Below are the steps to getting started:

- 1) Letter names and sounds
- 2) CVC Words (Consonant, Vowel, Consonant) words such as dog, cat, vet etc.
- 3) Diagraph sounds and words with Diagraphs (Ch, Sh, Ph, Th, and Wh)
- 4) Stop and assess these skills and make sure the student is solid with them before moving on!
