
• Main Event Location:

Event Do's and Don'ts

- DO stand in your booth and talk to people.
- DON'T sit your chair and wait for them to come to you.
- DO invite your community to MetaFest!
- DON'T talk yourself out of it by thinking you are bugging them.
- DO put your cell phone to the side when people approach you.
- DON'T text or Facebook in front of your guests.
- DO remember! Facebook live will bring in more customers!
- DON'T eat at your booth.
- DO work smarter, not harder.
- DON'T prejudge, you never know who needs your products or services.
- DO build a good relationship with the event coordinators.
- DON'T forget to secure your spot at our next event to receive our early bird discount.
- DO make the best out of your event, even if there is a low attendance.
- DON'T forget to meet the other vendors and leave your business cards with them.
- DO talk to everyone who passes by, if only to smile and say hello.
- DON'T forget your signage for your booth.
- DO make sure your area is the same or better than when you arrived to set up.



Guest Presenter Information

You will have 25 minutes with 5 minutes in between each speaker. Please plan to arrive at least 10 minutes before your scheduled time. You will have a microphone. Passing out items will be within your 25 minutes. We will not have power for slides or digital presentations. This is an old-fashioned lecture with Q&A. Invite your audience to your booth for more information. If you have any questions, please let us know.



Be Prepared

Be that highly skilled expert who is prepared for a 25-minute presentation including handouts during that time. Practice before you arrive on the stage. Let your handouts repeat the important information so you don't give a fragmented delivery.

Dress to Impress

If you have branded attire, be sure to wear that, because you will not be able to redecorate the stage to show off who you are. While you want to dress to impress, you also want to be comfy, and remember Merritt Island has a laid-back style. Just be yourself.

Present what has been Promoted

Whatever you have told bUneke you will speak about, don't go off topic unless your audience asks you to speak on something else. bUneke will promote your topic and nothing is more frustrating than attending a presentation on one topic to hear something different.

Keep your Pace and Volume Steady

When you are presenting, you want to ensure that you speak at an even speed – not too fast and not too slow. This is why it's important to practice. Speak with confidence. After all, **you** are the expert on this topic!

Be a Patient Speaker

Take a breath after delivering a key point. That way it will have time to sink in. You can also repeat the point to really drive it home, but don't keep repeating your same thoughts.

Use Visual Presentations Wisely

If you plan to use any props, be sure they are professionally designed and large enough for people to see from several rows back. Your best bet is to create enough handouts to give your audience.

Be Smart About Humor

Don't try to be a comedian if you're not, but don't be afraid to share your unique sense of humor, if it's appropriate.

Stay Positive

They have come to hear **you**, the expert in your field, speak on a subject they want to know more about. Start and end with gratitude. If you find you simply are not up for the presentation, speak with one of the coordinators about changing your place in the line up or plan to do it at a future event. Just remain positive.

Show Up

When you step onto that stage, be sure you are fully engaged. You must "show up" and be "on," ready to give your presentation like the expert you are.

Read the Audience

Are people leaving? Are they yawning? This may be time for the humor mentioned earlier.

Engage With Your Audience

Make eye contact for a real connection. Truly look at the people gathered who have come to hear what you are talking about. Don't read from notes. They are to remind you of key points, not to act as a wall between you and the audience. It's more important to make that human connection than to stick to your talking points. Your audience may have important questions and you won't know if you are looking at notes.

Tell a Story

An anecdote or an example is a great way to draw in the audience. It needs to be relevant though, or the audience will be left feeling a bit confused. You can do this at any time in your 25-minute presentation. Many find it works best in the beginning, to get attention, then at the end to wrap things up.

Allow Time for Questions

You don't want to ask questions if you don't have time to answer them. If your presentation takes 10 minutes, ask for questions, but if you talk for 20 minutes, tell them to meet you at your booth with questions, because you don't want to hold up the next speaker.

Ask for Feedback

Be sure to ask for feedback on your handouts. Some people won't be comfortable providing constructive feedback directly, so have a place on your handout for them to anonymously write their feedback and leave it for you or let them email you their comments.
