
Let's EDUCATE Pet Parents - Talking Points for Breeders

ESTABLISH AUTHORITY AS A PET PROFESSIONAL IN YOUR FIELD

Genetics vs. Environment and Lifetime Benefits

The pets you send to new homes are already healthy. They're genetically tested to ensure they're free from health issues that get passed down.
