Zachary: Even though, I lost the Costume Contest but I did enjoy the snacks and had an excellent time celebrating Halloween! I cant wait for next year's!



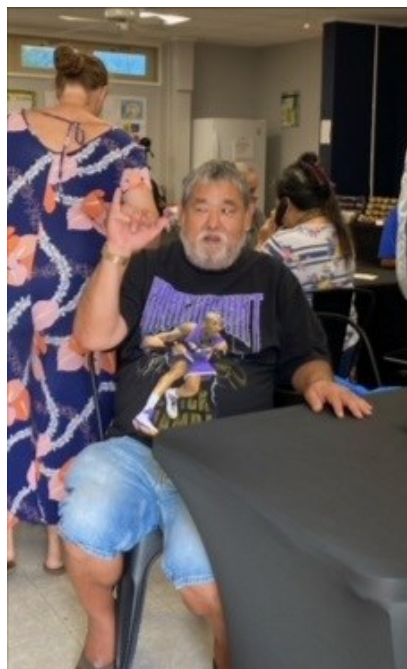
Vernon: It's the one time during the year that staff and members are not themselves.

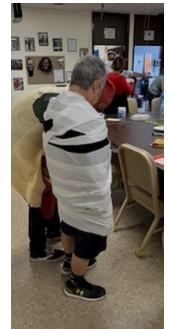

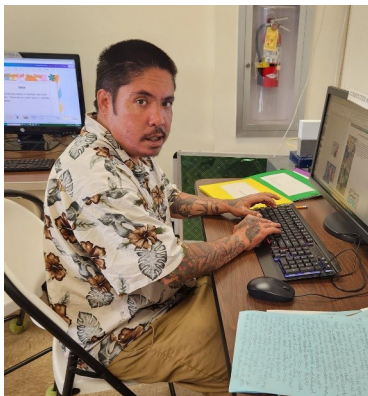
Birthdays
