LGBTQ+ History Month was created by Rodney Wilson, a high school history teacher in Missouri In 1995. It was originated in the United States as Lesbian and Gay History Month, and was first celebrated in **October 1994**.

In 1995, a resolution passed by the General Assembly of the National Education Association included LGBT History Month within a list of commemorative months.
