## **Museum Passes**

(effective 4/3/2024)

The following passes are available for check out with your Bucks County library card:

- Academy of Natural Sciences (2 Adults; up to 5 children in same household)
- Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve (2 Adults, up to 4 children)
- Bucks County Children's Museum (up to 6 individuals)
- Eastern State Penitentiary (up to 6 individuals)
- Elmwood Park Zoo (2 Adults; up to 6 children)
- Mercer Museum and Fonthill Castle (Up to 4 individuals, any age)
- Museum of the American Revolution (2 adults, up to 4 children; under 5 free)
- National Constitutional Center (2 adults, up to 4 children)
- **Pearl S. Buck House** (2 adults, and any # of children under age 18)
- **Pennsbury Manor (**4 adults and children under 18)
- Philadelphia Magic Garden (2 adults; up to 3 children)
- Washington Crossing Historic Park (Up to 4 individuals, under 5 free)

## **Guidelines**

Passes are available to all Bucks County Free Library cardholders, age 18 or older, in good standing.

Passes are offered on a first-come, first-served basis and are available for checkout for a non-renewable seven (7) day loan period, EXCEPT Elmwood Park Zoo which is a three (3) day loan period. Only one pass per family may be checked out at a time. Patrons may not borrow the same pass more than three (3) times in a calendar year.

**Passes must be picked up and returned in person to the Village Library of Wrightstown only.** If passes are returned to another library there will be a \$10 charge, plus an additional \$5 per day charge until the pass is received by the Village Library of Wrightstown (this can often take an additional 2-5 days, ie. an additional \$10-\$25 charges above all other charges).

Please DO NOT return passes in any book drop. If placed in our book drop, a \$5.00 fine will be charged to the library card.

The overdue fine is \$5.00 per day. If the pass is lost, the charge will be the full cost of purchasing a new pass. Once a pass is replaced, no refund will be given for a subsequently found pass.

Borrowers are responsible for calling the museum directly for hours of operation, parking, or directions. The pass may not provide admission to all exhibits. The Library is not responsible if a museum is unexpectedly closed or if a pass has not been returned on time.
