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STATEMENT OF CONSENT

Your child is being invited to participate in a research study because they are part of the community of study (A Washingtonian likely a descendant of U.S. chattel slavery). The Purpose of the Study: This listening session is part of the Charles Mitchell and George Washington Bush Study on Reparative Action and seeks to understand community perspectives on reparations and reparative action in Washington State.

Time Commitment: Participation will take approximately 1–2 hours.

What Participants Will Be Doing: Participants will engage in facilitated discussion and may be invited to respond to anonymous poll questions during the session.

Voluntary Participation: Your child's participation is voluntary. Your child may choose not to answer any

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Voluntary Participation: Your child's participation is voluntary. Your child may choose not to answer any question and may leave the session at any time.

Potential Risks: Some questions may involve sensitive topics and may cause discomfort. While the research team will take steps to protect your information, there is a small risk of loss of confidentiality associated with online participation.

Benefits: There is no direct benefit to participating. However, your child's input may contribute to a greater understanding of what reparations should look like for descendants of enslaved African peoples.

Confidentiality: Identifying information collected during registration will be stored securely and separately from listening session responses whenever possible.

Findings will be reported in aggregate, and no identifying information will be included in reports or publications.
