



The Polish Heritage Society of Grand Rapids supports Polish culture, values, learning and education by awarding several \$1,000 scholarships annually to students from West Michigan.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be of Polish American descent;
- reside in Allegan, Barry, Ionia, Kent, Montcalm, Muskegon or Ottawa county; and,
- plan to attend or currently attend an accredited 2-year trade/vocational program, 2-year community college program or 4-year college or university.

Applicants need to provide:

- this completed form;
- a copy of academic transcripts that show a minimum 2.75 GPA;
- two letters of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, coach, or advisor;
- a brief statement signed by them that delineates their Polish heritage; and,
- a 200-word essay that shares career goals and why they are deserving of a scholarship.

Applicants can provide additional information that they wish the scholarship committee to consider.

The deadline for applications is April 15, 2024. The Polish Heritage Society will notify recipients of the scholarships and financial aid offices of the institutions by May 15. Winners will be asked to provide a photo of themselves for a story in the Echo newsletter and will be invited to the Dozynki Polish Harvest Festival on Aug. 24 for special recognition.
