Dozynki is a Polish harvest festival, still celebrated today in rural parts of Poland. In the old days, after the harvest, the best girl harvester was selected as the queen of the harvest. She presented the lord of the manor with ceremonial gifts, a wreath made of grain and the traditional loaf of bread & salt. The lord of the manor would then host a big harvest festival with lots of good food and dancing.

One applicant will be selected to serve as Busia Queen. The winner will receive a donation to the charity of their choice made on their behalf of \$250.00.
