Open to string students who have studied for 2+ years, age 5+ (K-12). Repertoire must be memorized and may not exceed three minutes in total. Students will receive adjudicated. Students may provide their own accompanist, but an accompanist is not required. constructive feedback and a Certificate of Participation. Limited to 30.

**Festival II**

Open to string and wind students who have studied for 2+ years and under age fourteen. Repertoire must be memorized, at least three minutes and not more than five minutes. Students may provide their own accompanist, but an accompanist is not required. Students will receive adjudicated constructive feedback and a Certificate of Participation. Limited to 30.

Repertoire must be memorized, at least five minutes and may not exceed ten minutes in total. Students must provide their own accompanist. Students will receive adjudicated constructive feedback and a Certificate of Participation. Limited to 10.

**Senior Competition**

**\$250 Cash Prize**

Open to string, piano and wind students who have studied for 5+ years, ages thirteen through eighteen (K-12). Repertoire must be memorized, at least five minutes and not longer than twelve minutes. Students must provide their own accompanist. Students will receive adjudicated constructive feedback and a Certificate of Participation. Limited to 10.
