



Vendor Approval Guidelines

Peninsula Home & Lifestyle Expo

To ensure a diverse and high-quality experience for both vendors and attendees, all applications for the Peninsula Home & Lifestyle Expo are carefully reviewed by our selection committee. These guidelines outline the criteria and process we follow to make approval decisions.

Our Approval Criteria

We aim to create a balanced, well-rounded expo that showcases a variety of businesses and services. Applications are evaluated based on the following:

1. **Relevance to the Expo Theme**
 - Priority is given to vendors whose products or services align with home improvement, design, leisure, and lifestyle.
 - Businesses that reflect the values of the Bruce Peninsula community (e.g., sustainability, innovation, or local craftsmanship) are highly encouraged to apply.
2. **Category Balance**
 - To maintain a curated experience, we limit the number of vendors in each category (e.g., builders, interior designers, garden centers). This ensures that no single category dominates the show.
3. **Uniqueness and Quality**
 - Preference is given to vendors offering unique, high-quality products or services that stand out in their category.
4. **Local and Regional Representation**
 - We prioritize businesses based in Wiarton, the Bruce Peninsula, and surrounding areas to highlight and support our local community.
5. **Presentation and Professionalism**
 - Applications with clear descriptions and high-quality photos of products or displays are more likely to be approved. A professional and engaging booth presentation is expected from all vendors.

Approval Process

1. **Application Submission**



- Vendors must complete and submit the Vendor Registration Form by the stated deadline.
 - 2. **Committee Review**
 - All applications are reviewed by a selection committee. Decisions are based on the criteria above and our goal of creating a diverse and engaging event.
 - 3. **Notification of Approval**
 - Approved vendors will receive a confirmation email along with an invoice for their booth fee. Vendors who are not approved will also be notified.
 - 4. **Finalization**
 - Vendors must complete payment by the stated deadline to secure their spot.
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Important Notes

- **Waitlist:** Vendors who meet the criteria but cannot be accommodated due to category limits may be placed on a waitlist.
 - **Transparency:** Decisions are made objectively based on the guidelines above. We are happy to answer questions about the process.
