



Cribs for Kids® Caregiver Training

CURRICULUM

After receipt of a request from the primary caregiver, arrangements are made for the caregiver to pick up the crib and receive their safe sleep training.

The participant is given the following training upon arrival:

- The participant is asked to fill out the Safe-Sleep questionnaire.(See Attachment A)
- The participant is asked to visit www.safesleepacademy.org/safe-sleep-training/
- The trainer follows the Cribs for Kids® – Safe Sleep Education checklist (See Attachment B) to assure that all aspects of safe sleep are taught. The provider and participant initial each training point.
- The participant is asked to sign the Cribs for Kids® Hold Harmless Agreement (See Attachment C).
- The trainer demonstrates how to assemble the crib. With the use of a baby doll, the trainer demonstrates the correct sleep position (supine) the baby should be placed in for sleep. Part of the demonstration is placing the doll on its side and showing how easily it can end up in a prone position.
- The participant is given infant safe sleep brochures.
- When the infant is three months old, the participant is contacted by the Cribs for Kids® trainer and another questionnaire is administered over the phone. (See Attachment D)
