

Wapiti Area Synergy Partnership Meeting Notes March 13 2018

- 1) Meeting minutes from February meeting reviewed and approved; Richard Harris motion to approve, Rex Coupland second.

 - a. Feedback forms provided great suggestions including the provide speaker bio and agenda for the night.
 - b. Trade Show set up was well received.

- 6) Round Table (Highlighted Name indicate they attended meeting but did not provide an up date in time for minutes to be posted on WASP website)
 - a. CNRL: -We have no drilling rigs or completions going on at the moment. We have a couple completions to finish after breakup. We had a TDL on Bear Lake which will expire. Looking to source water elsewhere after breakup. We have one new pipeline being constructed from 13-33-71-08W6 to 11-14-72-08W6. It is a 6" sour emulsion pipeline spanning 8.4 km. Starts 3/4 mile west of HWY 724 on TWP RD 720. Ends 1.5 miles east of HWY 724 and 1/2 mile north of TWP RD 722.

 - c. Pipestone Energy Corp: Completed flow testing 3 new wells on the 15-14-070-08W6 pad. 5 well drilling program started this month at the 15-14 pad. Continue to work with landowners/residents on future drilling pads and pipeline ROW's

 - f. Cenovus: No new activity planned for Q2 and Q3 2018.
 - g. Keyera: Our pipeline program for this winter season will be wrapping up around end of March. Surface facilities work and the WLGf and GC are ongoing. A large amount of equipment will be shipping to site over the next 2 to 3 months with the remainder of the heavy loads shipping after road bans come off. Keyera hosting open houses March 20 (Wembley) and March 21 (Grovedale) regarding its North Wapiti Pipeline System.

h. **Tidewater:**

- i. **NuVista:** We have filed a non-routine application to the AER for the compressor facility in the NW-17-70-8-W6. Surveys have been completed on 4 of the 5 pad sites in our Pipestone project. The Team is reviewing the down-hole and inter well spacing that are associated with these surface locations. We hope that acquisition of these sites can commence after the middle of April. The drilling on these sites would not occur until Q1/2019. We have changed out the rods and down-hole pump at the 1-35-70-8-W6 location. This is a well that produces non-potable water. The site is +/- 900 m East of the Pipestone Creek Road on Twp. Rd. 710. There will be 2 trucks a day hauling water from this site for the next 60 days. We will suspend trucking during break up

- l. **CSV Midstream:** CSV is continuing their early engagement with landowners, area leadership and surrounding communities and associations. CSV is exploring the greater Wembley region for a new sour gas processing facility of significant size. CSV recognizes landowner concerns expressed regarding further injection wells in the area and therefore, CSV is pursuing alternatives to injection to manage the products of the process. CSV inquired about the size of EnCana's newly announced intention to apply for a sour gas plant as it appears to be within the same area CSV has been actively exploring.
