1) Introductions & Round Table

- a. **Tidewater** – two pipelines to be completed end of April. 2nd annual community clean-up day scheduled for the end of May. Plant under construction, foundations, some modules, and flare stack installed, pulling electrical cable
- b. **CNRL** - 15-28 pad flow testing postponed to May.
- c. **EnCana** – 2 rigs working in the area, 14-13-72-9W6 and 4-31-71-8W6, drilling for next 60 days. Completions at 6-6-72-8W6 (on stream May 22). Hauling on RR90.
- d. **TCPL** – Wapiti River crossing has encountered issues and delays. Deferred Huallen construction activities. Initiating clubroot testing for Huallen/Elmworth pipelines. 2021 program hearing will likely be in September 2019. Geotech work ongoing for Riverbend project.
- e. **SemCams** – drilling the Wapiti, pulling pipe at the end of April
- f. **Pembina** – will start drilling the Wapiti when SemCams is complete (same rig, same location).
- g. **Tervita** – landfill hours extended for summer season.
- h. **Pipestone** – 15-14 completions underway
- i. Keyera: Construction continues on the **Wapiti Water Disposal Pipeline** (from Keyera’s Wapiti Gas Plant (3-19-67-7 W6M) to two water disposal wells). Main section of pipeline was completed April 7. Lateral to be completed in June.
Wapiti Crude Oil Pipeline (from Keyera’s gas plant (3-19-67-7 W6M) to the existing Pembina Wapiti Station (SE 7-69-8 W6M) – Construction is complete. **Pipestone compressor station (8-15-70-8-W6)** – Construction continues with the second phase of

piling being completed and the majority of all major equipment arriving at site by the end of April. **Pipestone lateral pipeline** –The NPS 16 was completed in February 2019. Construction of remainder of line is ongoing, completion targeted for June. **North Wapiti pipeline system** (Keyera Wapiti gas plant at 3-19-67-7 W6 to the Keyera Pipestone Compressor Station at 8-15-70-8-W6) – Drill of the Wapiti River is complete. Construction will continue on the South side of the Wapiti River once dry conditions return. **Wapiti Gas Plant and Gold Creek Compressor Station** – The Wapiti gas plant is currently being commissioned. Official start-up is scheduled for May 1.

- j. **Husky Energy** – Finished drilling four wells on 13-26-072-10W6 Pad, next step is to frac these wells post break-up. A water retention pond adjacent to the 13-26 pad has been constructed and filled with water for the post break-up fracs. Depending on weather, these fracs will take place shortly after the May long weekend. Traffic management plans will be shared May 14.
