## 1) Introductions & Round Table

- **Kelt** – Drilling

2-3-73-8W6M (Hiway #724 & Emerson Trail)- May 11th commence drilling 3 Montney wells from existing pad with Rig release estimated July 1/19.

Completions

- 12-3-73-8W6M (Hiway #724 & Emerson Trail) Commence Summer 2019. Water is presently being sourced via private landowner sources.

- 16-8-72-7W6M (Grandview Rd & TWP 722) – Not yet scheduled.

Pipeline/Facilities

- No construction presently ongoing

- Proposed pipeline 12-3-73-8W6M (Hiway #724 & Emerson Trail) to 14-2-73-8W6M (TWP 730 & RR 82) to 1-14-72-8W6M (TWP 722 & RR81)- Surface Acquisition and Consultation ongoing with directly affected landowners. Resident visits within EPZ commencing week on May 13/19. Estimated construction start date of July 1/19.

- **CNRL** - We are just wrapping up our inline flowtest off our 15-28-701-08W6 pad. This well is kitty corner to the town of Wembley. All gas, oil and water produced inline to our battery. We had very minimal flaring and trucking from here.

- **EnCana** –4-31-71-8 W6 (RR90 South of TWP720)

9 wells being drilled from an existing padsite

- Drilling underway, two rigs on site
- Drilling began April 9, expected to be done mid-June
- Completions to follow

14-13-72-9 (West of RR90 & South of TWP 724)

- 6 wells drilled from a padsite
- Drilling completed mid-April Hydraulic fracturing finished May 1
- Wellsite facilities and well testing now underway

6-6-72-8 W6 (RR90 North of TWP 720)

- 6 additional wells on existing pad now on production
- Drilling began in January 2019
- All 10 drilled wells on pad are now producing

15-30-72-8 W6 compressor station (RR90 North of TWP 724)

- Construction now underway
- Scheduled to be onstream July 2019

Upgrade of TWP 720 between RR92 to RR90

- Partnership between Encana and County of Grande Prairie
- Scheduled to start upgrade in June (weather dependent)
- Encana will put up an ad on the WASP website and newspaper prior to construction
- **Pembina** – HDD under Wapiti is ongoing
- **Veresen Midstream** – Intends to submit pipeline application for Hythe Extension Pipeline project by end of May
- **NuVista** –  
Continue to drill at 1-19-70-8-W6 (Seiker) RR 85 1 mile South of Twp Rd. 704 Should be wrapped up in about 1 month

Frac operations to begin the week of May 21-25<sup>th</sup> at 8-5-71-8-W6 (Taylor) Will be here about 3 weeks ¾ mile East of RR 85 on Twp Rd. 710

Water transfer from Wapiti River to our reservoir at 13-18-70-8-W6 (Eckstrom) RR 90 1 mile South of twp. Rd. 704 We then transfer water to the 8-5 site

Looking to repair Twp. Rd. 704 between RR 90 and RR 84

Compressor site at 14-17-70-8-W6 1 mile South of Twp. Rd. 704 and RR 85 has been sold to CSV. NVA will continue to construct and will contract operate

- Keyera: Construction continues on the Wapiti Water Disposal Pipeline (from Keyera's Wapiti Gas Plant (3-19-67-7 W6M) to two water disposal wells). Main section of pipeline was completed April 7. Lateral to be completed in June.  
Wapiti Crude Oil Pipeline (from Keyera's gas plant (3-19-67-7 W6M) to the existing Pembina Wapiti Station (SE 7-69-8 W6M) – Construction is complete.  
Pipestone compressor station (8-15-70-8-W6) – Construction continues with general mechanical work which will continue into summer.  
Pipestone lateral pipeline –The NPS 16 was completed in February 2019. Construction of remainder of line is ongoing, completion targeted for June.  
North Wapiti pipeline system (Keyera Wapiti gas plant at 3-19-67-7 W6 to the Keyera Pipestone Compressor Station at 8-15-70-8-W6) - Construction will continue on the South side of the Wapiti River in May.  
Wapiti Gas Plant and Gold Creek Compressor Station – The Wapiti gas plant has been commissioned and is now operating.
