Match Play Differs From Stroke Play -


- 1. You may not play a 2nd Ball
- 2. You May & Should Resolve Rules Disputes Among Yourselves When You are Both Unsure of a Ruling - you can't agree to ignore the rules but if you don't know, find the best solution.
- 3. If you can't agree (declare you have a dispute and that you wish to resolve the ruling when the match is over. The status of that hole is undecided until you are able to get clarification). You must declare this before teeing off on the next hole.
- 4. Conceding Putts is Part of Match Play Keep it simple, Pick your ball up if putt is conceded.
- 5. In Four-ball (the format played in Summer Team), if your partner incurs a rules infraction or penalty it only impacts THAT player, not the side. A loss of hole may be applied just to that player(unless it is a serious breach,) your partner continues to play.
- 6. Playing From Wrong Tee Box: In Match Play if a player tees off from the wrong set of tees or in front of the tee markers the OPPONENTS may choose to a.) Recall the shot and make the person re-hit the shot, or b). Allow the player to play the ball. The player who made the mistake incurs no penalty, and if not recalled must play from that position on the course.

Order of Play


1st Hole (for Summer Team - home team goes first) Thereafter, the side who won the previous hole tees up first

Going out of Turn: The side further from the hole goes first (For pace of play purposes, on a hole by hole basis, you may ask to go out of turn if the other side is unable to play)

Cart Sense: Drivers, drop off your passenger (with Clubs) and travel to your ball if you can

- NEW Simplified Back on The Line Relief when using this relief option you are required to drop your ball on the line, and it may roll up to one club length in any direction. So, to be clear, that can also be forward.
