Many of you were present for the General Membership Meeting on October 7. Head Pro, Wes Tucker, made a detailed presentation of the redesign and renovation of the course. Details as well as a master rendering of the design can be found on the course website <u>www.sjgc.com</u>.

The course will be closed for renovations beginning in January 2022 with a scheduled re-opening in October 2022. During that time, LASJGC will continue to play as an organization. At the General Meeting, members discussed and voted on alternative courses where we will play. After much discussion the final decision was made to play each Tuesday at **Royal St Augustine** and each Thursday at **Palatka Golf Club**.

More details will be shared later concerning how to sign up and participate at our new locations.

In preparation for renovations, the course was sprayed with 3 different chemicals on October 25 & 26. The course will be sprayed again on November 8 & 9. This will occur in the afternoons and will not affect our Tuesday tee times. The spraying will result in a similar look to a really cold winter when the turf naturally goes off color and is dormant. The spray mix will have a green pigment added to it to help aid in the appearance. Playing conditions will be similar to dormant turf, and with it being dry, you can expect faster ball rolls through the fairways and rough.
