




For the past few years, TTR has helped create and prepare the track for the Topsham Fair's SkiJoring event, and we're happy to be doing so once again. This year, however, we have an outside group that will be assisting us—which is exciting news. I know several of you have expressed interest in helping, so please don't miss your chance. Snowmobile Safety

- Always wear a quality DOT helmet and facemask.
- Wear layers of clothing to keep warm and dry.
- Plan your trip and check the weather conditions before leaving.
- Always ride sober.
- Obey all trail signs and cross roadways with extreme caution.
- Always stay on designated snowmobile trails.
- If you must ride on ice, wear a life jacket over your outer clothing.

Despite a nice early start to the season with snow, the warmer temperatures that followed created some challenges. Even so, our trail crew has stayed busy doing everything they can when conditions allow. Jim Belanger has been out a couple of times grooming and completing regular trail maintenance, and the crew was also able to assist him with bridge work on that side of town. Over on the east side, DJ Merrill has been active with maintenance as well, and has been helping Brad Hoskins with grooming efforts on the East side of our trail system.

With the smaller storms we've been getting and the colder temperatures settling in, we're starting to see a decent base begin to form. However, to truly firm things up and make conditions more consistent throughout the system, we'll still need one good, solid storm. Please continue to report any hazards you come across so they can be addressed quickly. Conditions vary from section to section, but the crew is making steady progress and doing the best they can with what the weather gives us.

Below are some general pointers for snowmobile season. Please take a moment to review them in their entirety. As always, if you have any questions or encounter any issues, do not hesitate to contact me directly or send a message through our Facebook page—we'll address it promptly.

We have officially arrived into our snowmobile season. Take the extra time now to look over your sleds and make sure they are ready for some fun in the snow without the headache of being stuck out in the winter wonderland walking when you should be riding.

Please note that our trails will ONLY open to snowmobiles once we have fulfilled the following criteria:

- Received sufficient snow coverage
- Placed all appropriate cattle fences
- Opened the gates
- Cleared all of the trail obstructions
- Ensure that trails are properly signed

A reminder that there were some changes last season on trail #1A on the west side of town. That trail has been relocated to the trail that connects trail #1C in the powerline to trail #2A before Bradley Pond. Please pay attention to signs for the changes.

A reminder that snowmobiles are not allowed on Trail #1B this is an ATV only trail.

Please note that at this time ALL trails are closed to ATV's and UTV's. The only exception is ATV's/UTV's outfitted with snow tracks and registered as a snowmobile.

Miscellaneous Snowmobile Trail Information

Before heading out I would recommend that you review our trail map to ensure you are riding on the correct trails. It is worth mentioning that we do have many water crossings and we try to keep an eye on them for your safety. All ice and water crossings are ride at your own risk. If you do notice any thin ice, or come across signs indicating trail closed, please stay off. If you notice something that you think is not safe, please let myself or any of our assistant trailmasters know.

A reminder that the athletic fields, parking lots, and school grounds of Mt. Ararat High School are off limits to snowmobiles. Also, please take note that the tower area and the tower road are also off limits to snowmobiles.

We ask that you respect our landowners by staying on marked trails and obeying all posted signs. These folks are kind enough to allow us the use of their land. They are not required to and we can't thank them enough.

All snowmobile trails are operated on privately owned land. Landowners have the right to stipulate what can and cannot be operated on the trails that use their property. If these stipulations are not followed the snowmobile club will lose the use of that land owners property. Individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all snowmobile trails for everyone.

Please stay on our established trails if not we could lose the use of the trails all together. A reminder to use the marked bridges to cross wet stream and/or marshy areas on the trails. Failure to do so will result in sections of the trail being CLOSED permanently by landowners.

And finally, It goes without saying but trucks and cars are not allowed on ATV/Snowmobile trails anywhere in the State of Maine without landowner permission.

Park and Ride Locations:

East Side

Our park and ride on the east side of our trail system is located at the entrance of Mt. Ararat High School across from the bus garage. Please only use the small located there for loading and unloading.

West Side

We still do not have a parking option available on our West side. We are working on trying to locate one.

And remember folks when you do head out riding whether here in Topsham or around the state ride right and ride safe! If you have any questions at any time, please do not hesitate in contacting me on my cell phone which is 207-890-8479.
