As the ATV season winds down, we're excited to share that our trails remain open for now! We're aiming to keep them accessible until mid-December, weather permitting. For the latest updates, please check our Facebook page and website regularly.

A quick reminder: hunting season is still active, so stay alert and wear orange when riding in the woods. Please respect all hunting setups—they're on private property and may belong to landowners. If you're heading out, we kindly ask that you ride responsibly. Be aware of the deep-water holes on the west side of the trail system, and if you're riding solo, exercise extra caution.

With the leaves gone and temperatures dropping, snowmobile season is just around the corner! Now's the perfect time to enjoy your ATV rides before Mother Nature covers us in snow. Start prepping for winter fun!

Above all, ride safely—on or off our trails. Adventure is best enjoyed without injury. Respect the land and the landowners who make this possible.

Let's finish the season strong and responsibly!

Below contains pertinent information that everyone should be aware of when our trails do open.

Miscellaneous Information from the Trail Master

All of our ATV trails are operated on privately owned land, individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all ATV trails for everyone. Landowner's have the right to stipulate what can and cannot be operated on the trails that use their property. If these stipulations are not followed the club will lose the use of that land owners' property. Individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all trails for everyone. And remember that trucks and cars are not allowed on any ATV/Snowmobile trails in the State of Maine without landowner permission.



And remember if a Landowner wishes to limit the use of their property either for a short window of time or for an extended of time, they have the right to do so. Any club in the state cannot do what they do without the support of their landowners. So please help us help you by respecting our landowners. **Permission is required.** A person may not operate an ATV on the land of another without the permission of the landowner or lessee. Permission is presumed on designated state approved.

Operating an ATV in wetlands, marshes, rivers, and streams is illegal in Maine.

Please stay on established trails if not we could lose the use of the trails all together. Please use all marked bridges to cross wet, stream or marsh areas on the trails. Failure to do so will result in sections of the trail being CLOSED permanently by landowners.

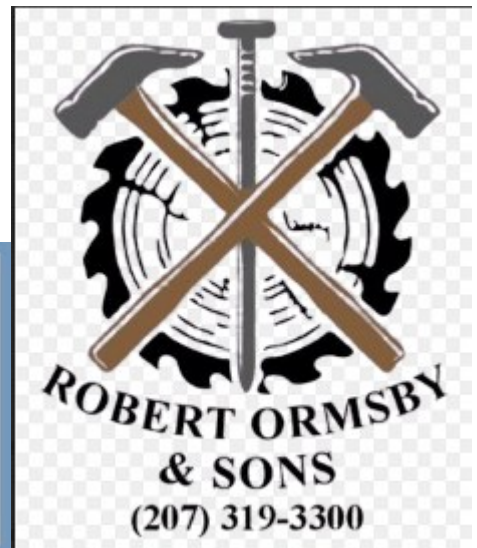
Dirt bikes and UTV's over 65" wide are not allowed on CMP Property period. This is a CMP rule that the club has no control over. The following trails are on CMP property #1B, RACE TRACK, #1C, and #4 from RT.196 to RT.24. Any dirt bike or UTV over 65" caught on these trails will be charged with criminal trespass.



The Speed limit in residential areas like Bay Park and Topsham Crossing is 15MPH to help keep dust down and the noise to a minimum.

RESPECT LANDOWNER'S - STAY ON MARKED TRAILS AND ONLY MARKED TRAILS AND OBEY ALL POSTED SIGNS. USE IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT.
