### **Trailmasters** Notes

All Trails are closed to ATV's/UTV's for snowmobile season. The only exception is ATV's/UTV's outfitted with snow tracks and registered as a snowmobile.

### ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY 25 FEET AWAY FROM ALL POW-ER POLES AND GUIDE WIRES.

It's SNOWMOBILE season again. The trails will open to snowmobiles once all cattle fences and gates have been opened, all trail obstructions have been removed, and the trails are properly signed. There will be some changes this season to trail #1A on the West side of town is CLOSED since the properties have been sold to new owners so to get around this there is a new trail that connects to trail #1C in the powerlines to Trail #2A before Bradley Pond. Please pay attention to signs noting the changes. A reminder that snowmobiles are not al-

lowed on Trail #1B because it is an ATV only trail. If you have not looked at the trail map you should do so before riding to ensure that you are riding on the correct trails this season. We have many water crossings and we do our best to keep an eye on them for your safety so if you see a sign that reads thin ice, or trail closed please stay off. If you notice something that you think is not safe, please let myself or the board now ASAP.

#### THE ATHLETIC FIELDS, PARKING LOTS, AND SCHOOL GROUNDS OF MT ARARAT HIGH SCHOOL ARE OFF LIMITS TO SNOWMOBILES. THE TOWER AREA AND TOWER ROAD ARE ALSO OFF LIMITS TO SNOWMOBILES.

# **RESPECT LANDOWNERS - STAY ON MARKED TRAILS AND OBEY ALL POSTED SIGNS. USE IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT. RIDE AT OWN RISK.**

The only authorized parking lot to use on the east side is across from the bus garage for loading and unload-

ing. Without property owners' consent there would be no trails for people to ride. Take the extra time now to look over your sleds and make sure they are ready for some fun in the snow without the headache of being stuck out in the winter wonderland walking when you should be riding.

# ALL ICE/WATER CROSSINGS ARE RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

All snowmobile trails are operated on private-

ly owned land. Landowner's have the right to stipulate what can and cannot be operated on the trails that use their property. If these stipulations are not followed the


snowmobile club will lose the use of that landowner's property. Individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all snowmobile trails for everyone.

Please stay on established trails if not we could lose the use of the trails all together. Please use Marked Bridges to cross WET, STREAM or Marsh areas on the trails. Failure to do so will result in sections of the trail being CLOSED permanently by landowners.

Access between the East and West side of town is not possible anymore due to the trail being closed by the landowner several years ago.

#### Access to and from Lisbon falls on trail #1C is not possible anymore due to a closed gate on the ward rd.

While riding please wear proper protective equipment and keep speeds at a safe level. Ride Smart, Ride Safe, Ride Sober.
