



All Trails in Topsham are open!

Assistant Trail Master (s) Sam Bulmer (West Side) Brad Hoskins (East Side) James Belanger (Winter) The trails continue to hold up rather well except for the Brigham trail which doesn't seem to dry out right away after a rain storm. We continue to be busy working the trails during our Tuesday night work parties and we are also excited that Bursey Enterprises was able to get out on portions of trails 1C and 1D to enhance those trails. We would appreciate it greatly if you please used 4-wheel drive rather than pressing the gas. This action alone will help preserve the trails significantly.

A reminder that we have a couple of large work parties scheduled during the month of September. The first one is scheduled for Saturday, September 8th. This work party will be held on the West side of our trail system. Please arrive before 9 am and be ready to work by 9. Please bring your machine, chain saw, hedge trimmers, shovels, screw guns, and a positive attitude. The next major work party is scheduled for Saturday, September 21st. This work party will be a MAJOR work party on our East side because we will be hauling material to different portions of our trails in preparations for our BBQ fundraiser. We will be using a tractor, machines and trailers to move material during this work party. A reminder that on Saturday, September 28th we will be hosting our 3rd annual BBQ and Ride on our East side. We will be departing from the Pulling Ring on the Topsham Fairgrounds at 10:30 am.

Also, a reminder to please stay off the trails during and the day after heavy rains. This cuts down on the damage that has cost our club a lot of time and money to keep our landowners happy. When you do venture out please ride safe on or off our trails, fun is to be had without getting hurt. Enjoy the rest of summer and remember to always respect the land to you ride on and that the landowners allow us to use!

Miscellaneous Information from the Trail Master

All of our ATV trails are operated on privately owned land, individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all ATV trails for everyone. Landowner's have the right to stipulate what can and cannot be operated on the trails that use their property. If these stipulations are not followed the club will lose the use of that land owners' property. Individuals damaging or abusing their property will result in the loss of all trails for everyone. And remember that trucks and cars are not allowed on any ATV/Snowmobile trails in the State of Maine without landowner permission.

And remember if a Landowner wishes to limit the use of their property either for a short window of time or for an extended of time they have the right to do so. Any club in the state cannot do what they do without the support of their landowners. So please help us help you by respecting our landowners.

Permission is required. A person may not operate an ATV on the land of another without the permission of the landowner or lessee. Permission is presumed on designated state approved.

Operating an ATV in wetlands, marshes, rivers, and streams is illegal in Maine.

Please stay on established trails if not we could lose the use of the trails all together. Please use all marked bridges to cross wet, stream or marsh areas on the trails. Failure to do so will result in sections of the trail being CLOSED permanently by landowners.

Dirt bikes and UTV's over 65" wide are not allowed on CMP Property period. This is a CMP rule that the club has no control over. The following trails are on CMP property #1B, RACE TRACK, #1C, and #4 from RT.196 to RT.24. Any dirt bike or UTV over 65" caught on these trails will be charged with criminal trespass.

The Speed limit is 5 MPH on the Trail behind Nouria Gas station, this is to help the trail stabilize due to soft soil.

The Speed limit is 15 MPH in the power line behind the shop on rte. 196, if this speed limit is not followed the trail will be closed permanently.

The Speed limit in residential areas like Bay Park and Topsham Crossing is 15MPH to help keep dust down and the noise to a minimum.

RESPECT LANDOWNER'S - STAY ON MARKED TRAILS AND ONLY MARKED TRAILS AND OBEY ALL POSTED SIGNS. USE IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT.
