Municipal Grant Update

Topsham's second run with a municipal grant is now complete. A couple weeks ago the final grant submission was made. Our downtown from the grant process is short lived because we will be heading out with Bursey Enterprises on Sunday, November 3rd to begin our 2025 preparations.
